3.1. Participating Boxers

- U19 Men's & Women's between the Age of (2008-2009)
U19 Men Weight Categories - 47-50Kg, 55Kg, 60Kg, 65kg, 70Kg, 75Kg, 80Kg, 85kg, 90kg, +90kg.
U19 Women Weight Categories - 45-48Kg, 51Kg, 54Kg, 57kg, 60Kg, 65Kg, 70Kg, 75kg, 80kg, +80kg.
- U23 Men's & Women's between the Age of (2004-2007)
U23 Men Weight Categories - 47-50Kg, 55Kg, 60Kg, 65kg, 70Kg, 75Kg, 80Kg, 85kg, 90kg, +90kg.
U23 Women Weight Categories - 45-48Kg, 51Kg, 54Kg, 57kg, 60Kg, 65Kg, 70Kg, 75kg, 80kg, +80kg.
- Reserve Boxers: If your National Federation is hesitating between two boxers, or simply wants to prevent any injury, please use the "Reserve Boxer" function in the database. This function will allow you to register more than one boxer in the same category, and you can choose last minute which boxer will participate even after registration ends (only one boxer will be allowed to compete in each category).

3.2 Team Officials

3.3 R&Js

- Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Coaches.- Only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- All boxers must be accompanied by at least one World Boxing certified coach at ringside during the bouts.
 - All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be World Boxing certified .
 - If any team does not have a certified coach, please raise this at the Technical Meeting so arrangements can be made with another team.
 - Any coach of National Level, who has not World Boxing certified, will not be allowed to enter the FOP.
 - All R&J's will be nominated by their respective National Federations and the final approval will be granted by Asian Boxing.
 - The R&J's nominated by NF should be World Boxing certified - The respective National Federations will pay the airfare for the approved RJ's and the LOC will provide transportation to venue, accommodation and per diem.

The process for obtaining a visa for Indonesia will be as follows:

- Team delegations that require entry visas will have their applications processed through the Indonesia Boxing Federation.
- All visas for the event will be issued in coordination with the Indonesia Boxing Federation.
- The cost of the visa will be USD 125 per person.

8. COMPETITION SYSTEM

- The Championships will be conducted according to current World Boxing Technical Rules.
- The Official Draw will be conducted by Swiss Timing system and Asian Boxing reserves the right to make changes in accordance with any situation.
- The Scoring System will be based on a "Ten Point Must System".
- There will be five (5) Judges for each bout in accordance with the electronic draw Scoring System.

10. BOXING ENTRIES CHECK

The Boxing Entries check is the final part of the event entry process. Asian Boxing and the LOC will inform Teams of their exact appointment time prior to the event as well as it will be displayed on the Team information board. The Boxing Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive timely for their respective appointment. Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Boxing Entries Check (e.g. Team Leader and the Team Doctor).

10.1 All boxers must bring the following items to the sports entries check:

- Boxer's Passports
- Boxer's International Record Books
- Boxer's Medical Certificate issued within the previous ninety (90) days and signed by the Boxer and by a doctor for each Boxer.
- Video and Image rights consent form
- Uniform and robe (if applicable)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy (Women Boxers aged 18 and older)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy (Women Boxers aged under 18)
- Sex Eligibility Policy - Certificate of Gender Test PCR (Polymerase chain reaction) or a functional medical equivalent genetic test to determine their sex at birth and certify their Eligibility to compete (Both Women and Men Boxers over the age of 18 years old).
- Conditions of participation form

10.2 Each team Delegation must also bring the following:

- National Flag 1X1.5 m
- National Anthem on USB Drive/ CD in mp3 format

10.3 Boxer's Uniform:

- The vest and shorts/skirt can be in the Boxer's respective national colours or in red or blue colour according to the Boxer's respective corner allocation
- Teams should review and ensure full compliance with the World Boxing Competition Rules, point 13.5, prior to arrival at the championship, to confirm that all uniforms meet the required standards.

10.4 Official boxing equipment

- All official boxing equipment used at Asian Boxing Championships will be provided exclusively by Asian Boxing through its official and exclusive equipment partner, Greenhill.
- No alternative equipment may be used unless expressly authorised in writing by Asian Boxing.



11. MEDALS

Medals will be awarded by Asian Boxing and provided by the Indonesian Boxing Federation.

12. ACCREDITATION

For Team Delegations

All delegation members who have registered for the Asian Boxing U19 & U23 Boxing Championships, Jakarta - 2026.. through the official Asian Boxing Registration Form by 01 June, 2026, will receive their accreditation upon payment of the accommodation fees to the Local Organizing Committee (LOC).

13. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation, and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.

14. MEDICAL SERVICES

The LOC will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

15. ANTI-DOPING

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World Anti-Doping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted during World Boxing Competitions.



16. IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING

- Asian Boxing retains full and exclusive image, broadcast, and recording rights for all Asian Boxing Championships.
 - Asian Boxing and its appointed partners are authorised to film and photograph the event for official, broadcast, promotional, and archival purposes.
 - Photography by accredited media is permitted only in approved areas and in accordance with Asian Boxing Media protocols.
 - Video recording of bouts or competition activity is not permitted unless expressly authorised in writing by Asian Boxing Media.
 - All filming locations within the venue are restricted and controlled by Asian Boxing Media. Only media accredited through Asian Boxing will be permitted to capture images or access media areas. Media accreditation requests must be submitted directly to Asian Boxing.
