IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR REGISTRATION

Each National Federation may register an unlimited number of boxing clubs from its country to participate in the Asian Boxing League.

However, each National Federation may only register a maximum of two boxers per weight category in total.

This limit applies across all clubs registered under that National Federation. The two boxers may represent the same club or different clubs, but the total number of boxers from one country in any weight category cannot exceed two.



4 - ELIGIBLE CLUBS TEAMS

The Asian Boxing League is open to teams representing organizations affiliated with their respective National Boxing Federation.

The following team categories are eligible to participate:

- * Boxing Clubs
- * Boxing Academies & Training Centers
- * Military Teams (Army, Air Force, Navy, etc.)
- * Police & Security Forces Teams
- * University & College Teams
- * City / Municipal Teams
- * Regional / Provincial Teams
- * Corporate / Institutional Teams
- * Any other team officially recognized and approved by the National Boxing Federation

12 - BOXING ENTRIES CHECK

Date: 06 December 2026

Required Documents:

- Boxer's Passports
- Boxer's International Record Books (from federation).
- Boxer's Medical Certificate issued within the previous ninety (90) days and signed by the Boxer and by a doctor for each Boxer.
- Uniform and robe (if applicable)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy (Women Boxers aged 18 and older)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy (Women Boxers aged under 18)
- Sex Eligibility Policy - Certificate of Gender Test PCR (Polymerase chain reaction) or a functional medical equivalent genetic test to determine their sex at birth and certify their Eligibility to compete (Both Women and Men Boxers over the age of 18 years old).
- Conditions of participation form

15 - COMPETITION SYSTEM

The Asian Boxing League 2026 shall be conducted according to:

- World Boxing Technical Rules
- World Boxing Competition Rules
- Asian Boxing Competition Regulations

Scoring System:

- Ten Point Must System
- Five Judges Per Bout
- Electronic Scoring System



16 - REFEREES & JUDGES

- Each participating Team Delegation may nominate and register one (1) Referee & Judge.
- All nominated Referees & Judges must hold a valid certification recognized by Asian Boxing and/or World Boxing.
- Asian Boxing reserves the right to approve, reject, or appoint any Referee & Judge based on certification level, experience and competition requirements.
- Asian Boxing may appoint Neutral Referees & Judges from member federations to ensure fair and impartial officiating.
- All Referees & Judges must attend the Official R&J Meeting and Technical Briefing.
- Bout assignments shall be conducted exclusively by the Technical Delegate and Competition Management.
